Program Speaker: This week our Rotary Club received an energetic and uplifting Red Badge Speech from **Fred Leung**.



Professor Frederick (Fred) Leung was born in Hong Kong and immigrated to the USA in 1970. He graduated from UC Berkeley with a BA in 1974 and a PhD in 1978. Following his graduation, he served as a Post-doc at Michigan State University from 1978 to 1980. He then worked as a Research Scientist at Merck & Co. from 1980 to 1985 and at the US DOE National Laboratory from 1985 to 1994. He is Internationally recognized as a Molecular Biotechnologist, and was elected as a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS) in 2009. He has asked the audience to remember three things from his speech. Fred became a lover of words and has a deep

love of knowledge. However, he said its not what you know that is important. Fred had dinner with Professor John Nash, Dr. Watson (Nobel Prize Winner for Double Helix); and Dr. Carl Wieman (also a Nobel Prize Winner). Fred encouraged everyone to celebrate life. He shared that he has six children and is therefore a "true biologist"! After retiring from The University of Hong Kong in 2016, following 23 years of service, Professor Leung has focused on science education. He has developed research courses for high school students, and his passion for science education continues unabated. Currently, Fred is alive and continues to look for challenging projects to serve humanity!
